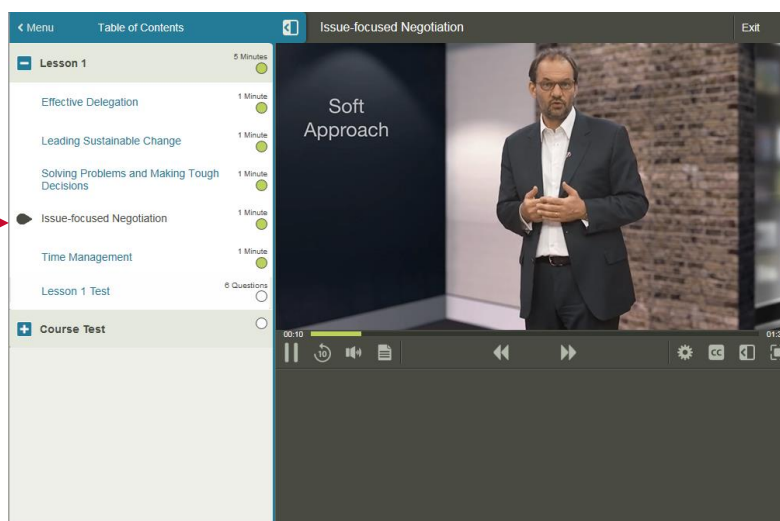

Slide-out menu provides instant access to course content and assessments, with duration and status information.

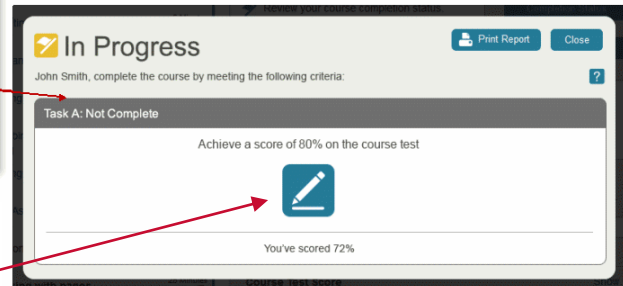
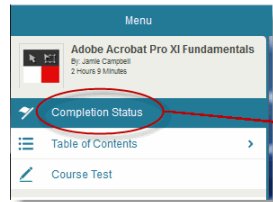


Video windows and controls allow you to set viewing size, playback speeds and captions, tailoring the video to your needs.

View task status to determine what still needs to be done to meet completion criteria. Click the icon to launch right back into the course to continue your progress.

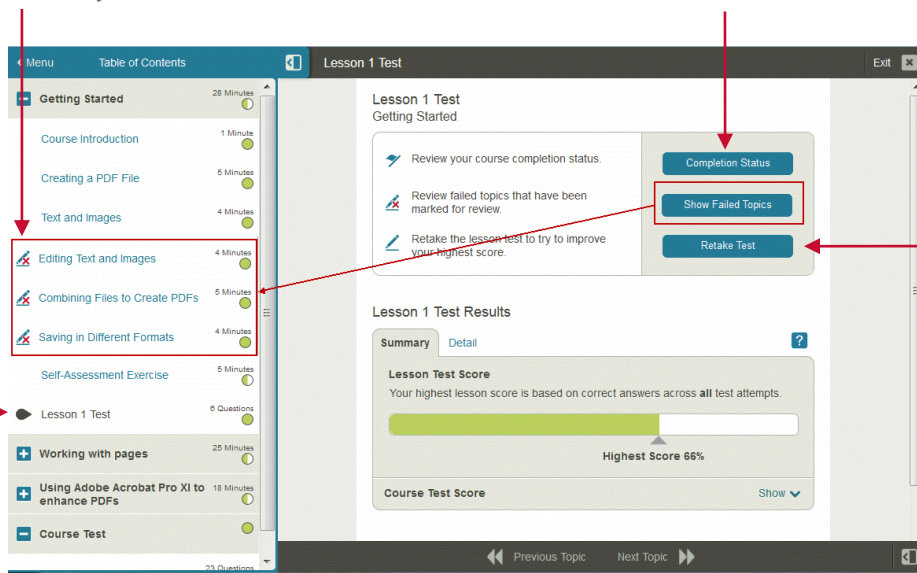
## Accelerate Mastery and Completion
