## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

### WHY DID SKILLSOFT MAKE THESE CHANGES?

We have moved our content to our latest technology. Skillsoft can now respond more efficiently to your requests for new and innovative features and services. With this new technology, we will soon be able to offer you from Skillsoft Percipio:

- **Risk dashboards:** These will provide risk management data for your reporting needs. They are currently in the design stage and are expected to launch in Q4 2024.
- **Dynamic content assignments:** This feature will enable you to create a single assignment where each user can answer a few questions and automatically receive the correct set of courses.
- **LMS improvements:** You will be able to configure a single integration that delivers Skillsoft Compliance and Learning content.
- **One platform:** Manage Compliance and Learning in one place, simplifying user management and reporting.

### WHEN WILL THE CONTENT UPDATES OCCUR?

The Compliance Suite courses will be published into your Compliance channels in Percipio on **September 5, 2024**.

The Compliance Suite courses will be in the Dynamic Content templates on September 9, 2024.

### HOW WILL I IDENTIFY THE NEW PERCIPIO COURSES?

We have designated the retiring versions of your Skillsoft Compliance courses as “Provider Content.” When an administrator searches for a Compliance course to assign, you will see the provider content flagged as “retiring soon” with the new Compliance Suite course listed underneath as “REPLACEMENT COURSE”. See the example below.

We always recommend learners access assigned Compliance courses through the Assignments area of Percipio. There learners can complete any assigned Provider courses and begin accessing assigned Compliance Suite courses as you rollout new assignments.

In Percipio, if learners search for Compliance courses, the Provider content will be lower in search results than the Compliance Suite courses, due to them being scheduled for retirement and archived.

Ninety (90) days prior to the course retirements, if a user launches a Provider course, the learner will receive notification that the course is scheduled for retirement. If the learner launched the course from search results, the learner will also see the recommended replacement Compliance Suite course. If the learner launched the course from the assignments, they will receive the notification but will not see the recommended replacement, encouraging them to launch and complete the assigned, retiring course.

## **WHEN WILL THE PROVIDER COURSES BE RETIRED FROM MY SITE?**

We will be retiring the Compliance Provider courses by December 31, 2024. We encourage you to move over to the updated courses at your earliest opportunity. Once you have completed the move to the new courses, reach out to your Skillsoft account team, and we can completely remove the retiring courses from your site.

## **WILL I HAVE TO UPDATE MY CONFIGURED COURSES?**

Yes, you will need to re-apply your configurations to the new Compliance Suite content. For instructions on how to reconfigure your courses, see [Configure a course](#).

## **WILL I HAVE TO UPDATE MY DYNAMIC CONTENT?**

Yes, you will need to create new Dynamic Content using the new Compliance Suite courses.

The Compliance Suite content will be added to the Dynamic Content templates on September 9, 2024. At that time, you may create new Dynamic Content using the provided templates or you may create your own from scratch. See [Dynamic Content Overview](#).

## **HOW WILL MY REPORTS CHANGE?**

You will now run reports for the Compliance Suite courses. If you have saved or scheduled reports for the Provider Compliance courses, you will want to create updated versions of these reports for the Compliance Suite courses. You may choose to continue using your saved reports with the Provider content included until you complete your assignments or programs utilizing this content.

## **WILL I HAVE TO UPDATE MY ASSIGNMENTS?**

Yes, you will need to transition your assignments to the new Compliance Suite content. We recommend finishing out the current assignments using the Provider (linked) courses and deploy the Compliance Suite content when you reassign the compliance course for the next program or due date.

## **WILL MY COMPLIANCE CONTENT LOOK DIFFERENT AFTER THIS UPDATE?**

No, this update will not change the look and feel of your Skillsoft Compliance content.

## WILL I NEED TO REASSIGN OR CURATE THE NEW CONTENT?

If you have created assignments or custom channels with the previous versions of the content, you will need to make new assignments and curate the new content into your custom channels.


When you transition your assignments to the Compliance Suite content, if you want previous completions for the Provider content to apply to the new assignments, you can upload these as admin-granted completions via completion and waivers workflow in Percipio. See [Completions and Waivers](#).

Please note, if you want learners to complete the Compliance Suite content in the new assignment from the beginning and previous completions not count for the new assignment, be sure to check the option to **Require learners to complete all courses from the beginning**. See example below.

Select how you want learners to interact with the content you add to the assignment. After you add content, use the up and down arrows to the left of each content card to change the order.

## HOW DO I MANAGE CONTENT CONFIGURATION AFTER THE UPDATE?

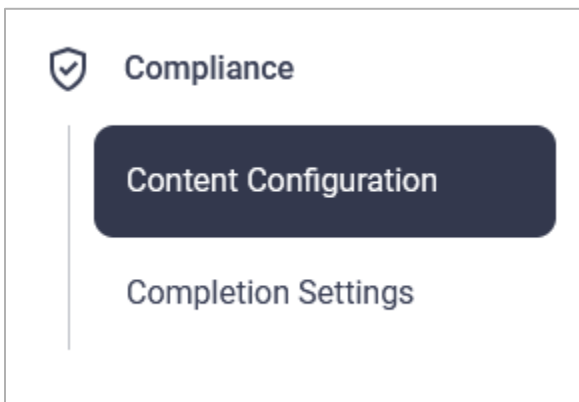
For all new content configurations, use the **Percipio Content** menu option. If you need to modify any existing configured Provider Content, you may still edit those configurations through the **Provider Content** menu option.

## HOW WILL MY ADMINISTRATIVE INTERFACE CHANGE?

For the Compliance Content Configuration and Completion Settings features in Percipio administrative interface, you will now see two options under each feature. One for the Provider Content and one for Percipio Content.

After September 5, you should use the Percipio Content for completion settings and configuration and begin transitioning away from the Provider content.
